Introduction

Since 1999, deaths from overdose in the United States have quadrupled,¹ in large part due to the over-supply of opioid analgesics.^{2,3} Recent evidence suggests that a "supply-side" approach—to limit the legal supply of these products—might have some utility, with research showing a reduction in the number of prescriptions issued for opioid analgesics in the United States between 2010 and 2015.⁴ Although the legitimate supply of opioids might have decreased, overall consumption will remain unchanged if users decide to source their drugs from illicit markets rather than from pharmacies.

The general efficacy of supply side interventions in drug markets is, however, under-researched.⁵ Although understanding has been limited by a lack of detailed information connected to illicit drug supply, knowledge has improved in recent years with the emergence of online illicit marketplaces, or "cryptomarkets." These cryptomarkets share many characteristics with legal online marketplaces such as eBay, including the provision of a decentralised digital marketplace in which geographically disparate vendors create "seller pages" to advertise goods for sale, and the use of customer feedback scores to rank sellers in terms of perceived product quality and service.^{6,8} Cryptomarkets facilitate anonymous use through their "darknet" location and payment by cryptocurrencies such as Bitcoin.^{7,9}

The internet has facilitated the sale of licit and illicit drugs for more than 15 years,^{10,13} but when the first cryptomarket, Silk Road 1, came online in 2011, illicit drugs began to be traded in large quantities. WHAT IS ALREADY KNOWN ON THIS TOPIC

The over-supply of opioid analgesics has contributed to the quadrupling of deaths from overdose in the United States since 1999

Limiting the legal supply of these drugs through the US Drug Enforcement Administration's ruling in 2014 to reschedule hydrocodone combination products, narrowed the circumstances in which opioids could be prescribed and stopped automatic repeat prescriptions

There are concerns that opioid users will source their drugs from illicit markets (cryptomarkets) rather than from pharmacies

WHAT THIS STUDY ADDS

The proportion of US cryptomarket drug trade attributable to prescription opioids increased immediately after the schedule change, with no statistically significant changes in other drug categories

The composition of the prescription opioid supply on cryptomarkets also changed, with fentanyl being the least purchased drug in July to September 2014, then the second most frequently purchased drug by July 2016

1. Introduction

The rise of 'dark net' drug markets, known as cryptomarkets, has led to the development of new methods of distribution of illicit and emerging substances (Schifano et al., 2006; Walsh, 2011; Wax, 2002). Cryptomarkets are accessible only through anonymising servers, with incoming connections stripped of identifiable information (Barratt, 2012). This allows members to sell and source drugs online with greater anonymity, and reduced risk of detection and prosecution (Martin, 2014b). While the technical aspects of cryptomarkets have been discussed in great detail elsewhere (Martin, 2014a), these markets operate in a similar way to other online markets, in which vendors are reliant upon consumer feedback to build and maintain reputation (Cox, 2016). Since cryptomarkets reached public awareness in 2011 (Chen, 2011), they have become well-established sources for purchasing and selling substances at an international level (Martin, 2014a).

1.1. Challenges of cryptomarkets

Cryptomarkets present a formidable challenge to law enforcement agencies tasked with interrupting drug supply networks (Reitano et al., 2015). In addition, cryptomarkets present an opportunity for marketplace moderators to defraud consumers, with little avenue for recourse or recovery of money (Tzanetakis et al., 2016).

1.2. Disruptions to cryptomarket operation

The seizure of the original Silk Road, the first cryptomarket to attract international attention, in October 2013 by the American Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), came after many months of intensive surveillance (Soska and Christin, 2015). This represented the first major disruption to cryptomarket operation, and was followed by a proliferation of alternative cryptomarkets including Silk Road 2.0 (Van Buskirk et al., 2014). The second major disruption came in November 2014 in the form of an international law-enforcement collaboration between the FBI, Department of Homeland Security, Europol, and other security agencies, dubbed 'Operation Onymous', and resulted in the seizure of multiple cryptomarkets.

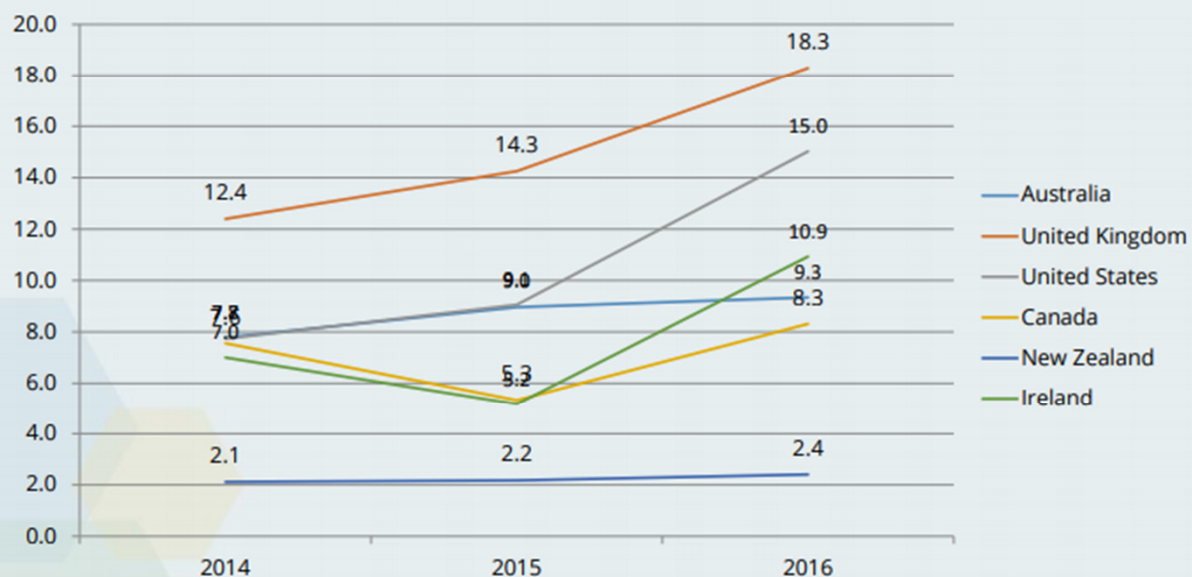

Recent darknet market use includes purchasing their own and getting someone to purchase on their behalf in the last 12 months.
Base: respondents reporting use of illicit/NPS/prescription drugs in the last 12 months.
Only countries with N=500+ in all 3 years are included.



English-speaking countries:

- Increases can be seen between 2015 and 2016 in UK, Ireland, US, Canada.
- Stable in Australia and New Zealand
- Changes in rates across years and differences in rates between countries could be explained by sampling differences

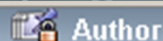

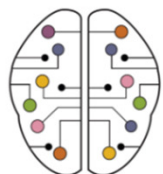

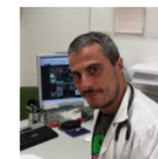

CHAPTER 7 The emergence of deep web marketplaces: a health perspective

Fernando Caudevilla

Introduction

Deep web marketplaces (DWMs) represent a major change in online drug trading. Although they are currently a limited phenomenon, their operational characteristics offer significant advantages for both buyers and sellers, and it is likely that their importance will grow. The structure of DWMs facilitates communication, exchange and dissemination of information. This provides opportunities for health professionals to engage with users. This chapter discusses some aspects of DWMs from a health perspective and describes harm reduction strategies developed specifically for DWMs.

The internet, drugs and health

The internet has changed many aspects of healthcare. Health professionals have traditionally been considered an undisputed and unique source of knowledge, and the role of patients has been to passively accept medical advice. However, this relationship has been transformed by the democratic access to information and the interactivity provided by the internet. Virtual communities, chats, discussion forums, online social networking services and virtual libraries are tools that change the balance of knowledge between health professionals and the public, empowering patients to become more involved in decisions related to their health. The internet is also a powerful tool for professionals, and clinicians and researchers have increased access to scientific publications, guidelines and professional tools that facilitate research and improve knowledge and abilities. On the other hand, dissemination of inaccurate or inadequate messages can have negative health consequences and is a growing concern, given that it is sometimes difficult to evaluate the quality of information online.

In relation to illegal or recreational drugs, these changes have been even more dramatic. Drug information provided through traditional media has tended to focus on universal prevention, encouraging people to reject any use of illegal psychoactive substances, not differentiating between use, abuse and dependence, and often exaggerating the negative aspects and consequences of drug use. In the age of the internet, however, resources focused on harm reduction, including more information about risks and harms, have gained popularity.

Alexa Internet⁽¹⁾ is a company that provides web traffic data analysis, classifies websites according to their global popularity and generates a score (Alexa ranking (AR)) that is considered the 'gold standard' for estimating the importance of websites on the internet, with lower AR scores denoting greater popularity. Websites aimed at providing harm reduction information, such as Bluelight⁽²⁾, Drugs Forum⁽³⁾ and Erowid⁽⁴⁾, have higher Alexa rankings (Bluelight, 16 356; Drugs forum, 19 965; Erowid, 20 670) than official prevention web pages such as the US National Institute of Drug Abuse⁽⁵⁾ (28 686) or the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC)⁽⁶⁾ (50 942). It is also important to note that harm reduction websites are generally run by volunteers or small non-governmental organisations with limited technical and economic resources compared with official government prevention websites. It is likely that these virtual communities of individuals using the internet all over the world are having an impact on social perceptions about illicit drugs.

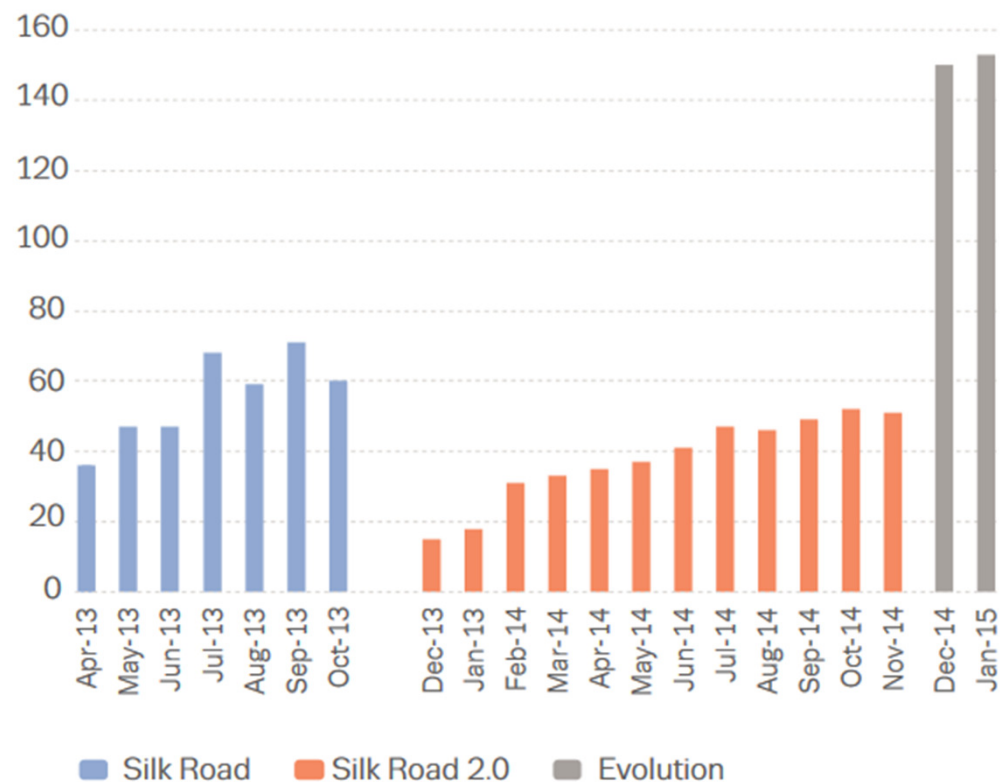

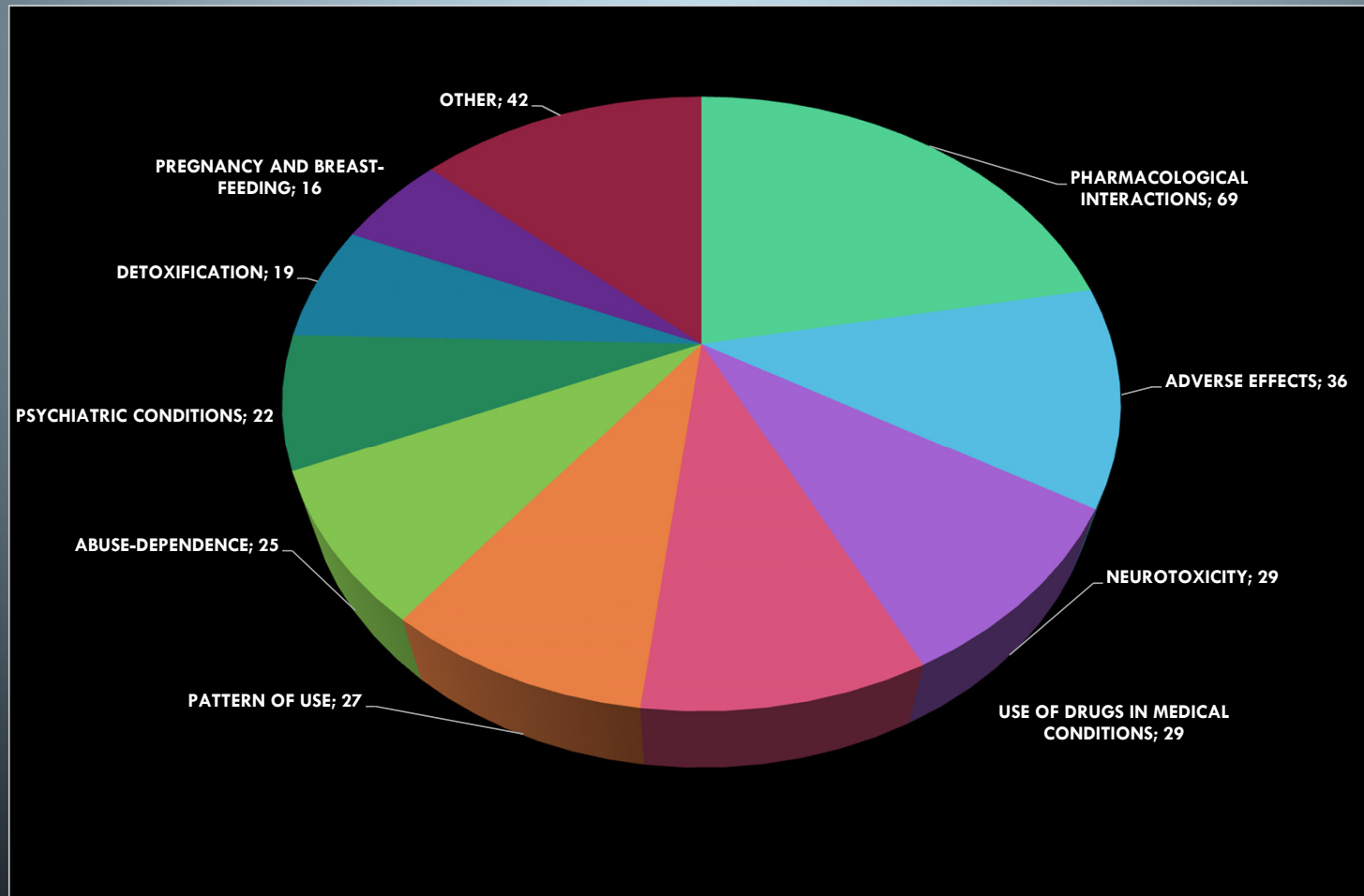

im on a new anxiolytic called buspar (buspirone), and i was wondering if it'll have any interactive effects with marijuana, MDMA, DMT, or LSD???

Doing ketamine after taking Paracetamol and/or Ibuprofen (recommended dosage)...Is it particularly dangerous? Can't imagine it's great for the liver? Not something to make a habit of but the ketamine distracts from the pain.

Mental Health

A friend of mine is diagnosed with schizophrenia probably triggered by marijuana abuse. (13-15 years ago)

He then stopped abusing substances for a while. He recovered, which by that i mean his social life got better, he could control voices he heard on his head, not being paranoid, etc. Few years ago he started using mj again and some mdma now and then. He did not show any signs of schizophrenia and his social life remained as is.

Now that he found his way into sr he want to try other substances too. He ordered 25(i,c or both, i am not sure) nbome, LSD and some opiates. Searching the web did not reveal anything about nbomes and schizophrenia but i found lots of reports that LSD triggered schizophrenia on some people.

Do you think a single trip on lsd or any other psychedelic could bring back effects of the schizophrenia? Do you think psychedelics should be avoided at all costs? What would be your advice on such situation?

A friend is interested in trying DMT after I recently introduced her boyfriend to it. There is a history of schizophrenia in her family while she herself has been diagnosed as being on the autistic spectrum. She is also currently diagnosed with depression and an anxiety disorder. Do you think DMT might be particularly hazardous for her and, if reasonably safe, are there any special precautions that should be taken?

What are the risks of the use of cannabis regarding schizophrenia? I have 3 members of my family who have/had schizophrenia. Although I take LSD and DMT more than weed, what are the chances of cannabis use activating a predisposed schizophrenic psychosis? As said, 2 members of my family have both been admitted to hospital after cannabis use has activated a schizophrenic psychosis, so how should I go about this? Stop smoking weed altogether or is it safe enough?

Not sure if you'll have time to reply or if this is your area of knowledge, but it would be useful to know.

Physical conditions

I have a friend who has/suffers from Supra ventricular tachycardia. He's had a few attacks in his life and is in the process of seeing experts about his heart. The recent scans he has had have actually shown that his heart is fine and healthy apart from some 'faulty wiring' (which I don't quite understand) and an ablation could be done to fix that. It's worth noting he suffers from quite bad anxiety at times and I personally believe this could be the possible cause but doctors don't seem to accept or address that.

Anyway to the question, for someone who has/had SVT attacks (around once a year but could be two in a year then not one for another two years) but no known abnormalities structurally what are the risks of doing say MDMA or LSD? He would love to try MDMA but obviously heart conditions and MDMA are generally a no go but I'm wondering if MDMA would actually be potentially dangerous?

Another point is he gets a bit anxious while smoking weed solely because of his heart and can feel it beating faster and worries him a bit (he generally feels like there's something really wrong with his heart but I believe it's the way he actually views it making the problem worse).

Adverse effects

I was wondering if you knew of any long term effects (positive or negative) from DMT use (heavy or not).

I would like to know more about the adverse effects of ketamine. How much is too much? How often is too often?

Psychedelic therapy

Is it myth that MDMA can help people suffering from PTSD? And if not, what other illegal drugs can help people with PTSD symptoms?

the subject i am asking about is kinda reluctant to ask their doctor about using illegal narcotics, but noting they are prescribing is helping at all. In fact, they are making it worse. She currently self medicates with xanax, but is looking for a less addictive alternative, such as psilocybin mushrooms (once a month) or maybe MDMA once or twice a month. Do you have any other recommendations?

Hello Doc, I was considering preparing Ayahuasca for therapeutic and entheogenic purposes, and I wanted to know if you had any experience with this preparation and how it compares to other psychedelics such as LSD and Mushrooms. I am going to take 6g of mimosa to 2g of syrian rue and sit around a camp fire. What subjective cognitive effects should I expect?

New Psychoactive Substances

So the question in short – Is there any proven theories, rumors, forum posts or anything that would confirm my theory that these epileptic seizures were caused by 25I-NBOME? Or is it even considerable that NBOMEs are connected to the epileptic seizures?

I am thinking about trying dissociatives...what should be the safest option...PCP, ketamine or methoxetamine?

For someone who hasn't used Ecstasy in 8 years and has never taken pure MDMA, what would you suggest as a dosage? What if this person wants to mix it with an NBOMe? Is that stupid? How much of each?

I am currently taking abilify (not sure on the dose, maybe ~5mg), Wellbutrin (I think 75mg), and cymbalta (60mg morning, 30mg at night) and I'm wondering how these will affect drug use. I've been experimenting with DMT and 25i-NBOMe and have noticed reduced effects and reduced visuals. I've also noticed with 25i I need to take larger doses (~4-5mg) to feel some effects with limited visual effects. I also plan on trying 2-CE soon. So my question is, are these diminished effects normal for someone taking the medication that I'm on? How can I get more pronounced effects from these drugs while on my medications? What should I do in terms of safety and dose regarding these drugs, specifically the 2C-E? And what dose should I take for the 2C-E? Thanks in advance for any advice.

Is it a good idea to stop a bad trip on mushroom or LSD with benzo's (I have Xanax and Valium)?

Should MDMA and amphetamines be avoided during lactation? Is it strictly forbidden or risks are acceptable?

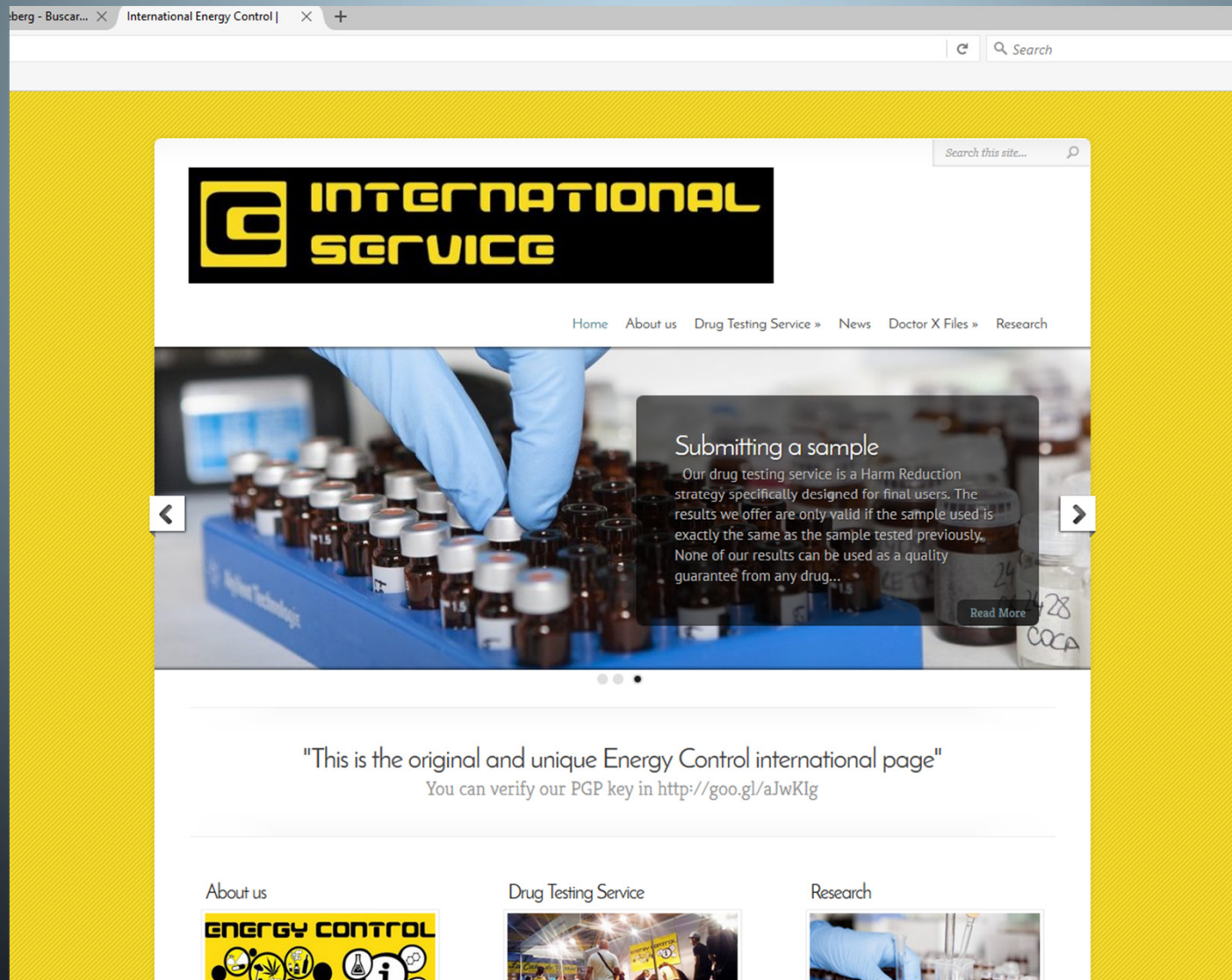

Ocfentanil: a novel fentanyl derivative detected as an adulterant of Heroin

Introduction

The popularization of anonymous markets such as Silk Road is challenging current drug policy and may provide a new context for old issues, such as adulteration of heroin with fentanyl derivatives. Ocfentanil is one of those derivatives: first described in a patent from 1986¹, it was evaluated in humans in 1989 but never reached the market. Effects of 3mcg/kg of ocfentanil were considered similar to those of 5mcg/kg of fentanyl. It exhibited analgesia and respiratory depression in a dose-related manner, with both effects peaking at 6 minutes. Analgesia largely disappeared after one hour, while respiratory depression tended to last longer².

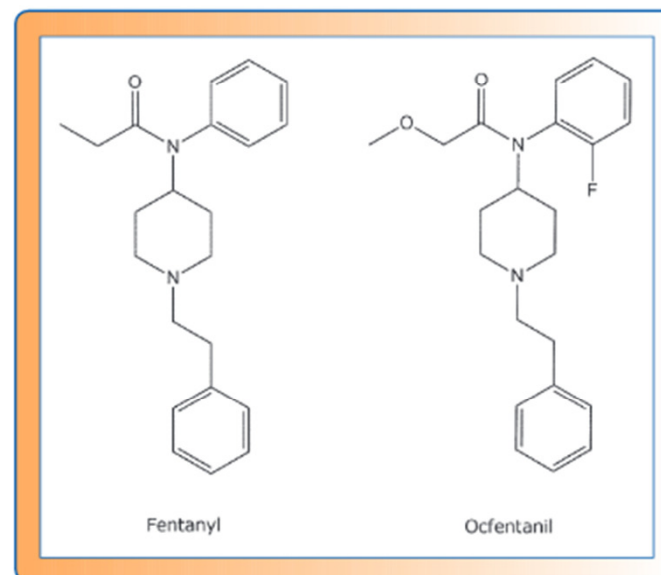
The aims of this work are to report the presence of ocfentanil, a novel, potent, non-controlled fentanyl analog, in samples sold as heroin in the deep web, and to summarize the effects reported by users.

Methods

Between 2015 and 2016, four samples bought as heroin in the deep web were sent to Energy Control for analysis. Energy Control is a Spanish harm reduction NGO that offers anonymous drug checking with the purpose of adapting counseling to the specific substances present in the drug and monitor the drug market. Identification was performed by GC/MS and LC/MS/MS. We contacted the submitters of the samples and performed an internet search to retrieve additional information.

Results

One sample contained ocfentanil, caffeine and heroin. Three samples contained the aforementioned substances plus paracetamol. Two out of the four contacted users reported distinct short acting, opioid-like effects. No for discussion could be found about the effects of ocfentanil, neither web pages nor individuals advertising the substance.

Provided by **Doctor X** & "International Drug Testing Service" from **Energy Control** which in collaboration with **ASUD** and **TechnoPlus**, has recently analyzed heroin samples (n°3, for smoking and n°4 intranasal/intravenous). We have been informed that **these samples were delivered through Deep Web Marketplaces** and offered from Europe (big sellers from France and Belgium).

In April 2015, in Belgium, a young man died after taking a brown powder he had bought on the deep web and actually **was ocfeantanyl**. In their June's newsletter, the British harm reduction project Wedinos said they had already analyzed six samples of **ocfeantanyl powder**.

These samples were suspicious for adulteration, and this idea has been confirmed. Analysis results shows ocfeantanyl presence, a synthetic opioid which is hundred times more potent than heroin. Effects are similar to other opiates, but this adulteration can increase overdose and severe adverse effects risks. Overdose-related fentanyl and fentanyl derivatives from opiate samples, have been recently reported in United States, Canada and Europe.

Energy Control warns heroin users who buy this product from Deep Web. There are no quick or qualitative tests for fentanyl and fentanyl derivatives. The only way to know the exact composition of a drug is submitting a sample to analysis. Energy Control offers users an **International Drug Testing Service**."

Fentanyl eller deras analoger säljs ibland utblandat i heroin. Zostaliśmy poinformowani, że próbki te zostały zakupione w działających w ciemnej sieci darkmarketach i pochodziły z Europy (od dużych sprzedawców z Francji i Belgii).

W kwietniu 2015 młody mieszkaniec Belgii zmarł po zażyciu zakupionego w ciemnej sieci brązowego proszku, który okazał się być **ocfeantanylem**. Brytyjski projekt redukcji szkód Wedinos doniósł w swoim czerwcowym biuletynie, że instytucja przeanalizowała już sześć próbek takiego proszku.

Próbki te były podejrzewane o zafalszowanie, co zostało potwierdzone. Analizy wykazały obecność ocfeantanylu, syntetycznego opioidu sto razy silniejszego od heroiny. Jego efekty są podobne do innych opioidów, ale takie zanieczyszczenie poważnie zwiększa ryzyko przedawkowania i wystąpienia niebezpiecznych skutków ubocznych. Przedawkowania związane z fentanylem i jego pochodnymi zostały ostatnio odnotowane w USA, Kanadzie i Europie.

Energy Control ostrzega użytkowników heroiny, którzy kupują ten środek w ciemnej sieci. Nie istnieją szybkie testy na obecność fentanylu i pochodnych. Jedynym sposobem poznania dokładnego składu narkotyku jest wysłanie próbki do analizy.

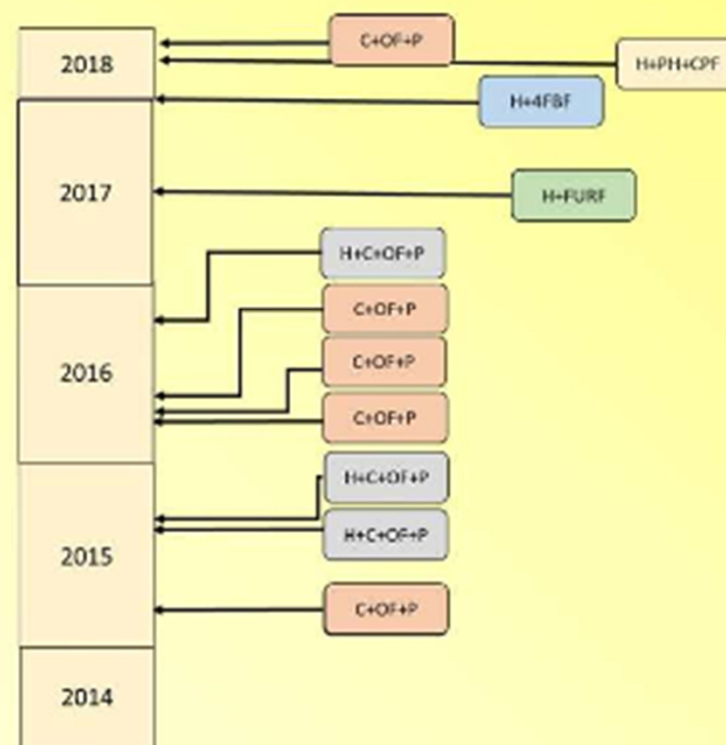

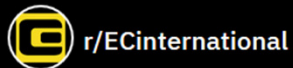

DARKNET HEROES LEAGUE MARKETPLACE BANS THE SALE OF FENTANYL

According to various news outlets, the death toll related to fentanyl overdose **has risen dramatically** over the past two years. In **Philadelphia alone**, a 632% increase in deaths were attributed to the potent opioid, as well as some of the more potent analogs, as recorded by both the CDC and law enforcement.

There is an unfortunate **connection** between fentanyl-related overdoses and the darknet markets, a connection that local law enforcement and the DEA are becoming alarmingly aware of. In many cases, other opiate or opioid products like heroin are being laced with fentanyl, ocfentanil, or even carfentanyl.

In an effort to aid in harm reduction, **some users** of darknet marketplaces have taken an interest in helping keep opioid users safe. Another **Reddit user**, who represent **Alphabay market** was offering to pay for a vendor account if someone was able to use it for selling only harm-reduction products, such as **Narcan**.

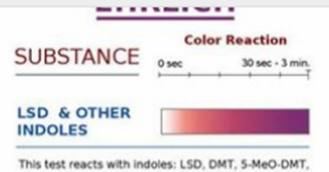

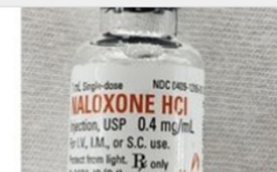

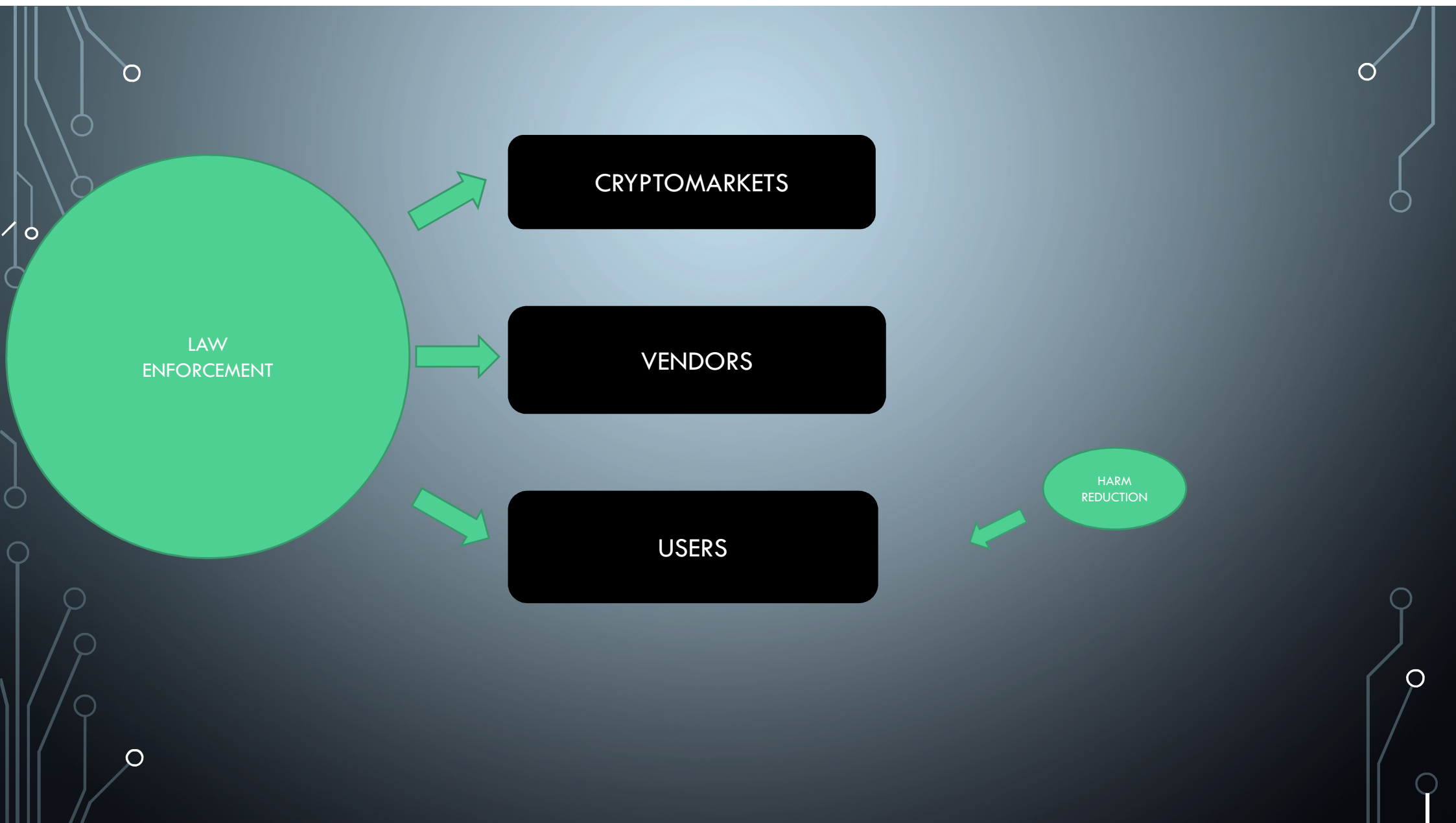
